4) Reports

- a) General Manager's Report-Good response to our kicking off the build a barrel with the customers in the community. Trying to get all customers signed up with the new operating system so everyone gets the alerts. North Texas has accepted our map and requested route for wholesale option with Rosehill. We won't know anything until April 26th whether it's been approved and then the board can vote at that time if we want to proceed. We have 3 developers willing to write checks to get more water down here for those new phases of construction. Which would give us about 200 million gallons per year. We actually bought and sold some investments that resulted in a gain this month. Material and labor were high this month because of all the new meters set we did in March. Income is behind since we streamlined our budget throughout the 12 months. Water sales were slower this month because of all the rain and it's that time of the year and water sales are down. Security monitoring was never billed in the last 2 years so that was an added expense to the budget we didn't plan on. Overall, we are right on budget. The study reveals 35 million between 5 districts and still have to put in a pump station and maintain the 20' line. Rosehill option would be a good fit since we have developers willing to help pay and it could happen within the next year.
- b) Field Report- Water loss Report for March
 - $2 \frac{3}{4}$ " valves blew off and lost 312,000 gallons
 - 2-1 1/2" lines loss 158,400 gallons
 - 1- 2" line water leak for a loss of 259,200 gallons
 - 1- 8" line leak for a loss of 86,400 gallons.

Auto flushers, dead ends, water quality and our trailer have usage of 1,994,400 gallons. Fire departments used the same usage every month.

3-Construction meters have a combined usage of 49,200.

There was 1 fire hydrant open on our system that belongs to no one, so we shut it down.
